largest white building in the back.



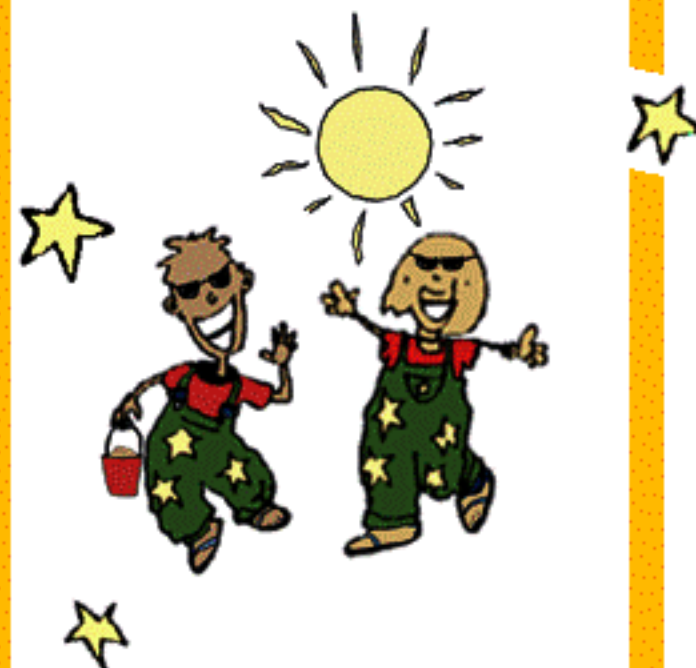
